Billet Doux enjoy designing your 'sweet notes'

You will need pencil, paper glue stick, fabric scissors, paper scissors & Appliglue ♦ select a template ♦ trace it off on to card & cut out ♦ mark the outline with pencil on the fabric of your choice & cut out. ♦ experiment with where you think the fabric will be best placed on the card ♦ apply light dabs of paper stick glue on the back of the fabric & place it firmly on to the card.

Hints ♦ read the free Appliglue leaflet & experiment on scrap paper before beginning. ♦ edge and embellish your fabric designs with Appliglue ♦ fray the finer fabrics to create interesting edges ♦ use your nozzle like a crayon ♦ blend colours ♦ water down colours with a few drops of water & a squeeze of Appliglue on a saucer. & blend using a cotton wool bud & wash the colour over the card surface for a faded background ♦ less is more – keep it simple

Other Ideas ♦ cellophane sweetie wrappers ♦ textured papers ♦ beads ♦ sequins ♦ buttons ♦ wool ♦ interesting threads ♦ fabrics ♦ keep the off- cuts of your fabrics for abstract designs ♦ extend your creations to gift tags, wrapping paper & dinner place cards.

Foiling ♦ if you have a piece of foil in your Billet Doux pack ♦ create your design outline with Appliglue ♦ let it dry completely ♦ place the foil over the top of the design, shiny colour facing you ♦ direct hot air from a hairdryer over the foil for 10 seconds & rub over the area with a tissue ♦ you will feel the raised impression of the Appliglue ♦ remove the piece & your design will be folled. Use the same technique for foiling on to fabric

Finally: Once you have created your card, allow it to dry overnight. Appliglue may remain slightly tacky. AppliCraft envelopes are specially made to protect your Appliglue design. If using a regular envelope place a piece of greaseproof paper over the design.
