

You will need pencil, paper glue stick, fabric scissors, paper scissors & Appliglué ♦ select a template ♦ trace it off on to card & cut out ♦ mark the outline with pencil on the fabric of your choice & cut out ♦ experiment with where you think the fabric will be best placed on the card ♦ apply light dabs of paper stick glue on the back of the fabric & place it firmly on to the card.

For other Ideas use ♦ cellophane sweetie wrappers ♦ textured papers ♦ beads ♦ sequins ♦ buttons ♦ wool ♦ interesting threads ♦ fabrics ♦ keep the off-cuts of your fabrics for abstract designs ♦ extend your creations to gift tags, wrapping paper & dinner place cards.

Foiling ♦ create your design outline with Appliglué ♦ dry – approx. 30 minutes ♦ place the foil over design, shiny colour facing upwards ♦ direct hot air from a hairdryer over the foil for 10 seconds & rub over the area with a tissue ♦ you will feel the raised impression of the Appliglué ♦ remove the foil ♦ **foil a solid background** ...use your finger or a paint brush and spread Appliglué over the surface ♦ allow to dry and proceed as before ♦ **use the negative** ♦ apply paper stick glue to the back of the foil and place it firmly in position ♦ heat, rub down and leave for a few minutes before removing the foil. You may choose not to remove the foil if preferred ♦ Appliglué colours are great used as backgrounds – it shows through the negative and acts as an adhesive too

Sparklethreads ♦ weave your own spangled web of fabric. Place the sparklethread between two sheets of tissue paper and iron on a silk setting briefly to fuse the threads into a solid piece. Fused pieces can be cut, punched stamped out for card design. Apply to fabric with AppliGlue

Finally: Once you have created your card, allow it to dry overnight. Appliglué may remain slightly tacky. AppliCraft envelopes are specially made to protect your Appliglué design. If using a regular envelope place a piece of greaseproof paper over the design.
